Your Pre-Election Checklist

Six Weeks Before Election Day

- Check your voter registration at votersvoice.info/vote.
- Update address / name if anything has changed.
- Note your state's registration deadline on your calendar.
- Decide: in person on Election Day, early in person, or by mail?

Three Weeks Before

- View your sample ballot (VOTE411.org or Ballotpedia).
- Research every race — including judges, school board, local offices.
- Use the Christian Candidate Rubric (see separate worksheet).
- Pray daily for your leaders and for your own heart.

The Week Before

- Confirm your polling place. It may have changed.
- Check your state's voter ID requirements.
- Plan your route and your time off, if needed.
- Text five Christian friends. Ask if they're ready.

Election Day

- Bring your ID (per state law). Bring your sample ballot.
- If turned away, request a provisional ballot.
- If you see a problem, call Election Protection: 866-OUR-VOTE.
- Pray before you cast your ballot. Vote your conscience.

After the Election

- Keep praying for whoever wins — every leader (1 Tim 2:1–4).
- Engage locally: school board meetings, town halls, neighbors.
- Stay registered. Update your address when you move.
- Keep the door guarded. This is a lifetime pledge, not one cycle.
